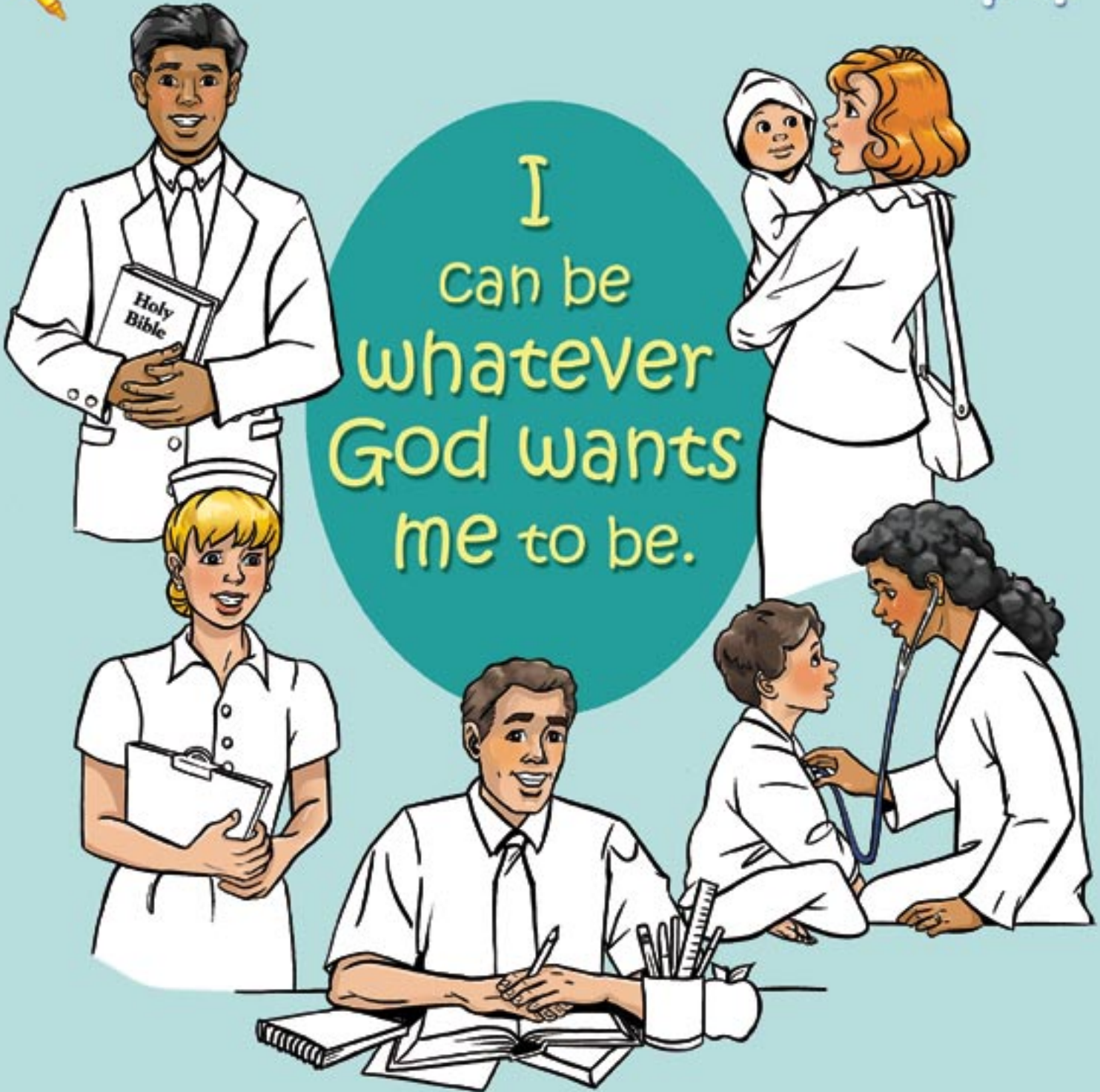

a person who speaks words from God

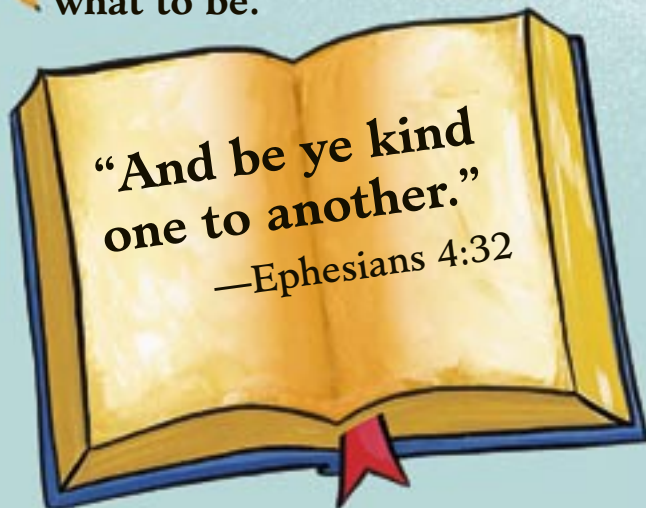
the river that parted with Elijah's mantle
